Palatine offers some great trails, along with a picturesque downtown area that makes this a comfortable, safe and entertaining experience. In addition, all the profits will go to an all-volunteer dog rescue organization. This event has it all – chocolate, exercise, charity, furry friends and fun! We hope you join us.

## HOW IT WORKS

It all begins (and ends) at **Morkes Chocolates** where bicyclists of all ages gather for their first chocolate taste - a fresh made, chocolate dipped donut and coffee, iced or hot tea or water. Maps will be handed out, questions will be answered and the tour begins. In addition to the tastings at each stop, you can fill your water bottles and use the bathroom facilities.
